POLICE REPORT 16/08/21 - 17/09/21

16/08 – Bonnybank Court – Teenagers congregating at this location which has been several times now. They are drinking alcohol, taking drugs and playing loud music. Police attended and they had already moved on.

17/08 – Woodrow & Clearburn Road – Numerous calls throughout the month regarding people late teens, shouting, swearing and kicking over bins. Believe to be associated to a problem address there. Neighbours have been advised by housing to report any anti-social behaviour in the house.

21/08 – Park Hill – report of a smell of cannabis emulating from a property. Police attended and could not smell anything from the property. Intelligence submitted.

21/08 – Arniston Miners Club – Police called regarding a male assaulted by another male resulting in reporter losing some teeth. Enquiries carried out and the male responsible has been charged for serious assault and reported to the Procurator Fiscal.

23/08 – New Hunterfield – 3 cars stolen from one property. A door has been left insecure allowing access to car keys. Vehicles have not been recovered and enquiries are ongoing with Dalkeith CID.

23/08 – Newbyers Crescent – Police received a call about youths congregating in the street and throwing bricks. The group of teenagers consist of about 15 of them congregating there or within the grounds of Arniston Rangers football club. They are causing a lot of antisocial issues in Gorebridge which Police are trying to tackle.

26/08 – Barleyknowe Road & Maclean Place – Call received regarding a male youth on an off road motorbike riding it on the road with no helmet on. The male was followed by a group of youths walking to the field he went into. This is a common issue at the moment and the people reporting have been encouraged to take photos where possible in order for Police to identify the male.

27/08 – David Herkes Way - Police called regarding a fight in street involving a few males with weapons. 2 males arrested and charged for numerous offences and kept in Police custody to appear at court.

29/08 – Hunterfield Road – Police officers observed a vehicle driving with no lights on at night. Vehicle stopped and it ascertained that the driver was driving the vehicle with no insurance or
