POLICE REPORT 15/07/ 2021 – 16/08/2021

15/07 – Birkenside – Police called regarding a resident making threats to a neighbour. Police carried out enquiries and the resident was charged for making the threats and kept in custody to appear at court.

17/07 – David Herkes Way – 2 calls received regarding drug dealing from a property. Intelligence documented by Police.

17/07 – The Avenue – Call received regarding a male shouting and banging on a door. Police attended and the male was arrested, charged and kept in custody to appear at court the following day due to the severity.

18/07 – The Crescent – 2 males assaulted with injuries within the street. Enquiries ongoing with Police to trace culprits.

18/07 – David Herkes Way – drugs warrant executed at a property within the street. Substantial amount of drugs seized from the property and the occupier charged with numerous offences. Occupier has been reported the Procurator Fiscal.

20/07 – Kwei Lin Chinese takeaway, Hunterfield Road – Staff at the takeaway reported a male entering the property and stealing a bottle of alcohol. CCTV collected and efforts made to identify the culprit.

21/07 – The Crescent – Police called to a property regarding a male causing sever harm to himself. Police and ambulance attended and were successful at keeping the male alive.

21/07 – Barleyknowe Road, Burnside Road and other surrounding streets – Calls received regarding an off road bike driving on the roads and fields erratically

22/07 – Arniston Rangers Football club – Hunterfield Road – numerous calls over the month regarding youths congregating at the stand area of the grounds. The youths are often loud, abusive and throwing an array of different items into gardens of properties in Parrot Lane behind. One of the items thrown was a full tin of soup. There are young children that play within the gardens of these properties and there is a growing concern that they or others could get badly injured. Officers are attempting to give the area as much passing attention as possible to tackle the problem.

25/07 – Gorebridge Primary School – call received regarding youths within the grounds knocking bins over and being a nuisance. Police attended and the youths had already dispersed.

29/07 – Braeside Road North – Police officers observed a male known to them running away from officers. He was caught and found in possession of tablets believed to be Valium. He was advised they would be sent for analysis and should they come back as illegal he will be reported.

30/07 – Carlowrie Place – Police received a call regarding petrol haven been poured through a letterbox believed to be due to an ongoing feud. Enquiries still ongoing and suitable safety advice been given.

10/08 – Vogrie Hall, Vogrie Road- report of youths possibly breaking into premises. Police attended and traced 2 youths who hadn't broken in but were found in possession of cannabis. They were charged for the offence and reported to youth justice.

11/08 – David Herkes Way – Report of a disturbance at a property. Police attended and there was nothing ongoing however 2 males were found with personal amounts of cannabis within. They were charged and reported for this.
