POLICE REPORT 17/09/21 – 17/10/21

21/09 – Gore Avenue - A vehicle parked on Gore Avenue had the windscreen smashed during the night. No indication of suspect, enquiries are ongoing.

21/09 – New Hunterfield - Police made aware of youths loitering in the area, jumping fences causing nuisance to residents. Community police are on tasking to tackle this.

23/09 – Primrose Gardens – Report of a garden in the area being vandalised, fixings had been ruined and items within the garden pushed over and damaged. Police enquiry is ongoing.

23/09 – A vehicle filled up on fuel at the Newton Loan Filling Station, the vehicle then drove away from the site without paying. Police have carried out checks on the vehicle and will follow up with the driver at the time of the theft.

24/09 – Powdermill Brae - About 0450 hours, an alarm was sounded in the rear garden of an address on Powdermill Brae. Police attended and no suspects were traced. A male was observed on CCTV to break padlocks of a shed and attempt to gain entry, no items were taken. Enquiries are ongoing.

24/09 – Murderdean Road - A motorcycle and Fork Lift have been involved in a road traffic collision. The male driver of the motorcycle was reported to the Procurator Fiscal for careless driving due to his manner of driving before the collision.

24/09 – Birkenside - Whilst a vehicle has been parked in the area another vehicle has caused damage to it by bumping into it. The offending vehicle then left the scene failing to provide vehicle details to the owner. Police enquiries are ongoing.

28/09 – Early hours of the morning, persons have entered a unit at Mountskip Farm by forcing entry. A red Honda quad bike was then stolen. Enquiry is ongoing.

01/10 – A female has entered a store in Gorebridge taken various items from open display to the value of £200 and left the store making no attempt to pay. Police enquiry is ongoing.

01/10 – Roseberry Crescent - Police observed two males in the area to smell of cannabis, upon search herbal matter was recovered. Both males were issued with recorded police warnings.

02/10 – Newbyres Avenue – Youths in the area throwing rocks at properties, police attended and no trace of youths. Details obtained and follow up carried out with residents.

02/10 – Hillside Crescent North – Report of noise coming from a house in the late evening. Police attended and warned occupier of the complaint. No further issues identified.

07/10 – Arniston Public Park – Report of around 20 youths knocking over bins and setting them alight. Police attended and minor fire set, no trace of the youths.

09/10 – Springfield Place – Misuse of drugs warrant carried out by police at an address. Small amount of cannabis recovered, suspect traced and reported.

13/10 – Hunterfield Park – Report of a smashed window to a house, police enquiry is ongoing.

16/10 – Hillside Crescent North – Youths using footballs in the area against tenants fences. Engagement made with youths and no further issues identified.
